

**2009 STONE CUP,
the 4TH ANNUAL CITY/COUNTY GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP
for Jackson, Madison County, Tennessee.**

WHO: Participants include children and adults who are past Champions or either reside, work or are members of a golf club in Madison County, Tennessee and have are not currently golf professionals or have entered a golf tournament as a professional unless amateur status has been reinstated.

WHAT: an 18/36 hole stroke play format to determine age group winners and to qualify the top eight (8) open players for the Champions Round Match Play to determine the City Champion.

WHEN &

WHERE: The stroke play tournaments shall take place on Saturday 18 July & Sunday 19 July 2009, at Falcon Ridge on Saturday and Jackson National on Sunday. (Jones Creek is the alternate site).

Winners of age/gender divisions will be determined at the completion of stroke play.

Upon completion of the stroke play, the low junior (18 or less) will be awarded the Tommy Talkington Cup given in memory of Tommy Talkington.

Stroke play after 36 holes in the Open Division will be used to determine the top eight (8) qualifiers for Champions Round Match Play that will be conducted on Saturday, 25 July and Sunday 26 July, 2009 at the Jackson Golf and Country Club. The final match will be a 36 hole match play with the winner being the Jackson City Champion who will receive the Albert A. Stone, Jr. Cup.

DIVISIONS: *(Subject to change and number of entrants)*

Age 12 & under shall play 9 holes on Saturday and Sunday to determine Boys and Girls Champions.

Age 13-15 shall play 18 holes on Saturday and Sunday to determine Boys and Girls Champions.

Age 16-18 shall play 18 holes on Saturday and Sunday to determine Boys and Girls Champions.

Age 19-30 shall play 18 holes on Saturday and Sunday to determine the Male Champion.

Age 31-40 shall play 18 holes on Saturday and Sunday to determine the Male Champion.

Age 41-50 shall play 18 holes on Saturday and Sunday to determine the Male Champion.

Age 51-60 shall play 18 holes on Saturday and Sunday to determine the Male Champion.

Age 61- and over shall play 18 holes on Saturday and Sunday to determine the Male Champion.

In order to qualify for the Champion's Round, you must play from the Championship tees. One may win the age flight as well as qualify for the Champions Round. The Champions Round qualification is open to all entries regardless of gender or age. Women divisions will be established based on the level of entries. Birthdays will be established as of 15 July 2009.

Championship Rules and Regulations
18-26 July 2009

Eligibility : Entries are limited to eligible amateur players (children 12 years and older and adults) who are past Champions or either reside, work or are members of a golf club in Madison County, Tennessee and are not currently golf professionals or have entered a golf tournament as a professional unless amateur status has been reinstated in accordance with the USGA Rules. Entry is subject to rejection at anytime (including during the Championship) by the Championship Committee. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct.

Age: All players must list their age and date of birth on the Championship entry forms. Age for division status will be established as of 15 July 2009. Players who are less than 18 years old must have a parent/guardian submit and sign the appropriate Championship Entry Form.

Entry Forms: It is the sole responsibility of every player to make sure the entry form and entry fee is received no later than **5:00 pm C. D. T., 15 July 2009** at Jackson Country Club, 31 Country Club Lane, Jackson, Tennessee 38305, telephone # 668-0688/ facsimile # 668-4258 and will be automatically rejected if received after that time and date. Late entries will be rejected. The risk of delay or transmission is solely upon each player.

Entry Fees: Green fees and cart fees are included in the entry fee. Children less than 16 years old will have to either walk or may use a cart if accompanied by a parent for which there will be an additional cart fee.

Children - 12 or less (\$25.00) 13-18 years old (\$35.00) 19 years and older (\$75.00)

Competition Format: The USGA rules of golf as supplemented by local rules will apply. Decisions of the Championship Committee will be final. Electronic Measuring Devices will be allowed for use in the Championship.

(a) Children less than 12 years old will participate in a 18 hole stroke play competition (9 holes each day) conducted over two (2) days on 18 & 19 July 2009 at Falcon Ridge and Jackson National Courses. (Jones Creek is the alternate course for Sunday's round). Tee times and golf course locations will be announced by **12:00 noon, Friday 17 July 2009**. Age and gender divisions will be determined by Championship Committee and trophies will awarded to division champions.

(b) Players over the age of 12 years old will participate in a 36 hole stroke play competition (18 holes each day) conducted over two (2) days on 18 & 19 July 2009 at Falcon Ridge and Jackson National Courses. (Jones Creek is the alternate course for Sunday's round). Tee times and golf course locations will be announced by **12:00 noon,**

Friday 17 July 2009. Age and gender divisions will be determined by Championship Committee and trophies will awarded to division champions.

(c) Any player 13 years and older and possessing an USGA handicap of 10 or less may declare to qualify for the match play portion of the Championship. Such players must declare for such status on the Championship Entry Form and must play from the Championship Tees as designated by the Championship Committee regardless of the players age or gender. Players will also be eligible for their age divisions as well. After completion of the 36 hole stroke play, the low eight (8) players will qualify for the Match Play Tournament to be conducted on 25 & 26 July 2009 at the Jackson Country Club. In the event of ties, players will be determined by on-course playoffs.

(d) Players participating in the March Play portion of the Championship will play 18 hole matches conducted on Saturday morning and Saturday afternoon resulting in the two (2) finalists who will play a 36 hole match on Sunday determining the Jackson City Champion and recipient of the Albert A. Stone, Jr. Cup.

Golf Carts and Caddies: Use of golf carts shall be in accordance with local rules. Green fees and cart fees are included in the entry fee. Children less than 16 years old will have to either walk or may use a cart if accompanied by a parent for which there will be an additional cart fee. One caddy per player is permitted and may ride in the golf cart with the player upon payment of the cart fee.
